

BASIC & ADVANCED FORENSIC PHOTOGRAPHY

OVERVIEW

The basic photography course is recommended for crime scene investigators or sworn officers who are responsible for the documentation of crime scenes through photography. Students will learn basic camera functions, the exposure triangle, composition of photos, and the various types of photos taken on crime scenes. This course will also cover using filters, evidence photography, basic flash functions, and courtroom testimony. This class will be composed of lectures, practical exercises, and mock crime scenes. No prior experience or trainings are required.

Casual attire and comfortable shoes are recommended as this class has a heavy emphasis on practical exercises.

- Camera (DSLR or mirrorless)
- External Flash
- Off-shoe flash cord
- Tripod
- Macro Lens
- Filters - polarizing, orange, red, yellow*

Recommended Supplies:

- Monopod
- Any other photography equipment you have!
