## Detailed Description

Enters ten prints, performs quality control and search verification on the Automated Fingerprint Identification System; makes identifications of prints; compares prints to determine whether fingerprint cards match prints on file; verifies each match; identifies name and history associated with fingerprints. Conducts comparisons, such as, judgement sheets, court orders, etc., serves as an expert witness; testifies at depositions, trials, or other court functions as required. Assists the Medical Examiner's Office by identifying the fingerprints of deceased individuals that have the potential to have biological contamination. Receives evidence that has been chemically processed for fingerprints and turned over to the Latent Print section. Assists other agencies with their requests to search for, compare, and identify fingerprints. Performs other duties as assigned.

## Job Requirements

- Bachelor's degree supplemented by a minimum of one (1) year previous experience in fingerprint identification. **OR**  
Associate's degree supplemented by a minimum of three (3) years previous experience in fingerprint identification. **OR**  
High School diploma supplemented by a minimum of five (5) years previous experience in fingerprint identification.
- Vocational/technical training in fingerprint science and latent print examination. (*Certificate of Completion to be uploaded at the time of application but no later than the closing date of the posting.*)
